## GOA, India's Hippie Paradise

### Day 01

Arrive in Goa and transfer to hotel Goa Marriott or similar. Rest of the day free to relax.

### Day 02

Morning free. In the afternoon visit Old Goa. Once a powerful and glorious City, rivaling Lisbon in its magnificence, all that remains today are imposing Churches and convents. The most important of these are the Se Cathedral, the largest Church in Asia, and the Basilica of Bom Jesus, famous throughout the Roman Catholic world. The experienced Guides showing you round will explain the fascinating histories of both buildings and you can view the mortal remains of the Patron Saint of Goa, St. Francis Xavier. Also visit the Museum of Christian Art. Later come to Panjim, the capital city of Goa to board the boat for a cruise down the Mandovi River before you head back for your hotel.

### Day 03

Day free to relax and explore on your own. *Overnight in hotel.*

### Day 04

First of all you will proceed to visit the magnificent temples of Shri Shantadurga - dedicated to Shantadurga the Goddess of peace and Shri Manguesh- an 18th Century hilltop temple. These are two of the most important temples in Goa each of which have lamp towers, which are a distinctive Goan feature. After your morning visiting the temples, we take you up into the hills to visit a 160-year-old Spice Farm where the welcome will be as warm as the crops they grow. After a wonderful Goan-style lunch by a Lotus Pond you will walk through this lovely Plantation and learn how to use your Spices for a lot more than just flavouring food. After lunch depart for your hotel. Evening free.

### Day 05

Day free to relax and explore on your own. *Overnight in hotel.*

### Day 06

Depart the hotel for the airport to board your flight onwards.
